Section 2.33(b)(2) - Veterinary Care. Each research facility shall establish and maintain programs of adequate veterinary care that include the use of appropriate methods to prevent, control, diagnose, and treat diseases and injuries.

- The registrant was not following their own standard operating procedures (SOPs). The SOP states that the animals will be monitored for pain every 20 minutes. There were several instances where the 20 timeframe was not observed. Animal #1 had two periods of more than 20 minutes. Animal #2 had two periods of more than 20 minutes. Animals #3, #4, #5, #6, and #7 all had one period of more than 20 minutes. The SOP for monitoring pain must be followed.

This affects seven animals.

To be corrected on all future procedures.
