**INSTITUTIONAL ANIMAL CARE AND USE COMMITTEE (IACUC).**

Section 2.31(d) - IACUC review of activities involving animals. The IACUC shall conduct a review of proposed activities related to the care and use of animals and determine that the proposed activities are in accordance with the Animal Welfare Act.

- The IACUC approved a protocol that did not have documentation to demonstrate that a medical database search had been performed. This search must indicate that the proposed animal use will not duplicate previous studies. All protocols must contain this information before they are approved by the IACUC.

This affects all animals.

To be corrected by the next IACUC meeting.

Section 2.31(e)(2) - A proposal to conduct an activity involving animals, or to make a significant change in an ongoing activity involving animals, must contain a rationale for involving animals, and for the appropriateness of the species and numbers of animals to be used.

- One protocol did not have adequate justification for the number of animals involved in the study. The protocol stated the need for five pregnant animals which the primary investigator (PI) hopes will result in ten neonates. The protocol needs to state that ten neonates are needed for the study, and this number must be justified. If a statistical analysis is the justification for the number of animals, the statistical model or method must be provided. This protocol must have additional clarification for the number of animals used in the study.

This affects 13 animals.

To be corrected by the next IACUC meeting.
