\* Protocol did not adequately provide a rationale for the number of animals to be used in the narrative. The number of animals to be used for each compound was stated but no rationale was provided to justify why that number of animals was necessary. The number of animals required should be clearly and scientifically justified to assure that no more animals are used than are necessary for scientific validity. All proposals to conduct an activity involving animals must contain a rationale for the numbers of animals to be used and the rationale must be made available to the inspector at the time of inspection.

(3) A complete description of the proposed use of the animals.

\*Although the IACUC protocol application requires the investigator to list the length of time that animals are continued on study and the method of disposition of animals at the termination of the study, protocol did not provide a specific time range for animal use on the study or a method of disposition of the animals. A complete description of proposed animal use should include the information required by the IACUC including how long the animals will be maintained on the study and disposition post-study in order to assure appropriate treatment and care. The facility must assure that all proposals involving animals contain a complete description of animal use including duration and disposition.
