(2) A rationale for involving animals, and for the appropriateness of the species and numbers of animals to be used;

did not provide an adequate justification for the number of animals used in the study. The protocol stated, "The number of animals selected in each age group is considered to be the minimum necessary to produce the desired number... needed to evaluate the endpoints of the study." This does not provide an adequate rationale for the number of animals selected. The number of animals required should be clearly and scientifically justified to assure that no more animals are used than are necessary for scientific validity. All proposals to conduct an activity involving animals must contain a rationale for the numbers of animals to be used. To be corrected prior to use of this protocol.
