(2) A rationale for involving animals, and for the appropriateness of the species and numbers of animals to be used;

\*\*\*Protocol involving dogs did not have an adequate justification of the species chosen. There is no documentation that the IACUC discussed alternative species, such as pigs, that may also be appropriate. This protocol was later amended to use pigs instead of dogs. IACUC should discuss alternative species and require more detailed and thorough justification of species, when other species may be appropriate. Correct for all future protocols.
