**HOUSING FACILITIES, GENERAL.**

Sec. 3.1(a) Housing facilities, general. Facilities and Operating Standards. Structure; construction. Housing facilities for dogs and cats must be designed and constructed so that they are structurally sound. They must be kept in good repair, and they must protect the animals from injury, contain the animals securely, and restrict other animals from entering.

\* The expanded metal gate bottoms on the pens listed below need to be repaired. These sections of expanded metal that were riveted to the gate frame have become detached from the frame work allowing the bottom and top edges of this expanded metal to gap open along the framework. This must be replaced or repaired in a manner that it contains the dogs securely and protects them from injury. The pens are as follows:

South pens : counting from the door--2, 5, & 6

**3.6 ( b ) ( 4 )**

**PRIMARY ENCLOSURES.**

Sec. 3.6(b)(4) Primary enclosures. Primary enclosures for dogs and cats must meet the following minimum requirements: Resting surfaces. Each primary enclosure housing cats must contain a resting surface or surfaces that, in the aggregate, are large enough to hold all the occupants of the primary enclosure at the same time comfortably. The resting surfaces must be elevated, impervious to moisture, and be able to be easily cleaned and sanitized, or easily replaced when soiled or worn. Low resting surfaces that do not allow the space under them to be comfortably occupied by the animal will be counted as part of the floor space.

\* Two cat cages on the bottom row of the south cat cages and the middle cat cage in the recovery room did not have elevated resting surfaces installed. During the inspection one elevated resting surface was installed in the middle pen on the bottom row of the south cat cages. The other two pens must still have elevated resting surfaces installed.
