INDOOR HOUSING FACILITIES.

Indoor housing facilities for dogs must be sufficiently ventilated at all times when dogs are present to provide for their health and well-being and to minimize odors, drafts, ammonia levels, and moisture condensation. It was noted during the routine inspection that the room housing seven dogs contained a strong chlorox/urine odor. The overhead vent contained flaking paint and debris needed cleaning. The room odor is caused by inadequate ventilation. The discolored vent is probably due to moisture condensation as a result of insufficient ventilation.

SANITATION.

Premises (buildings and grounds) shall be kept clean. It was noted during the routine inspection that the overhead vent in each of the pig rooms contained flaking paint and an accumulation of debris. These noncompliant items were pointed out and discussed with management the need of proper sanitation to facilitate good husbandry practices as required by the regulations.
