There were 3 rabbits exhibiting signs of wry neck . These rabbits have a hard time maintaining normal posture. Water fixtures are located on the top of the cage and reaching the water would be difficult for a rabbit who can not maintain normal head posture. Water must be placed in a location which is easy for these rabbits to reach . Correct By : 6-23-06  
The facility has a new treatment plan which calls for ivermectin injections as treatment for wry neck. The attending veterinarian must be consulted concerning treatment for rabbits with wry neck . Correct By : 6-26-06
