PRIMARY ENCLOSURES.

Primary enclosures for dogs and cats must meet the following minimum requirements:

4) Resting surfaces. Each primary enclosure housing cats must contain a resting surface or surfaces that, in the aggregate, are large enough to hold all the occupants of the primary enclosure at the same time comfortably. The resting surfaces must be elevated, impervious to moisture, and be able to be easily cleaned and sanitized, or easily replaced when soiled or worn. Low resting surfaces that do not allow the space under them to be comfortably occupied by the animal will be counted as part of the floor space.

The resting surfaces in the enclosures of the (120) cats are plastic containers that are light in weight, unstable and are usually used by the cats as a enrichment toy or a bedding box rather than a resting surface. These plastic containers need to be replaced by devices that will serve the function as resting surfaces.

PRIMARY ENCLOSURES.

All primary enclosures for guinea pigs and hamsters shall conform to the following requirements:

(a). (4) Primary enclosures equipped with mesh or wire floors shall be so constructed as to allow feces to pass through the spaces of the mesh or wire: Provided, however, That such floors shall be constructed so as to protect the animals' feet and legs from injury.

It was noted during routine inspection that twenty-four rabbit cages were being used to house guinea pigs. There were five guinea pigs in each cage. The guinea pigs' feet were observed to pass through the wire flooring which predisposes the animals' feet and legs to injury. These animals need to be moved to cages that protects the animals' feet and legs from injury.
