HOUSING FACILITIES, GENERAL.**

Supplies of food and bedding must be stored in a manner that protects the supplies from spoilage, contamination, and vermin infestation. The supplies must be stored off the floor and away from the walls, to allow cleaning underneath and around the supplies. All open supplies of food and bedding must be kept in leakproof containers with tightly fitting lids to prevent contamination and spoilage. It was noted during the routine inspection that approximately ten opened bags of dog food stored on the floor and in a gondola in the food storage room of the SAC. One opened bag of dog food and another were observed stored on the floor against the wall in the building housing the six Great Danes. It was discussed and explained to management that all open supplies of food must be kept in leakproof containers with tightly fitting lids to prevent contamination and spoilage. Management was also informed to store all supplies off the floor and away from the walls to allow adequate cleaning.
