EACH RESEARCH FACILITY SHALL ASSURE THAT THE ATTENDING VETERINARIAN HAS APPROPRIATE AUTHORITY TO ENSURE THE PROVISION OF ADEQUATE VETERINARY CARE AND TO OVERSEE THE ADEQUACY OF OTHER ASPECTS OF ANIMAL CARE AND USE. AT THE TIME OF THIS INSPECTION, IT APPEARS THAT THERE IS NO WRITTEN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THIS RESEARCH FACILITY AND THE "BACK-UP" VETERINARIAN. TO BE CORRECTED BY: AUGUST 15, 2006

A MECHANISM OF DIRECT AND FREQUENT COMMUNICATION IS REQUIRED SO THAT TIMELY AND ACCURATE INFORMATION ON PROBLEMS OF ANIMAL HEALTH AND WELL-BEING IS CONVEYED TO THE ATTENDING VETERINARIAN. AT THE TIME OF THIS INSPECTION, TWO RABBITS ARE EXHIBITING SIGNS OF PAIN IN THEIR RIGHT EYES (IE KEEPING THEIR RIGHT EYES CLOSED; SWOLLEN SKIN AROUND THE RIGHT EYES; HUDDLING IN THE REAR OF THEIR CAGES). TWO ADDITIONAL RABBITS ARE KEEPING THEIR RIGHT EYES OPEN, BUT THE EYE IS RED AND THE SKIN AROUND THE EYE IS SWOLLEN. THESE FOUR RABBITS HAVE APPARENTLY HAD A PROCEDURE DONE THREE DAYS AGO. THERE IS NO EVIDENCE OF ANY POST-PROCEDURAL ANALGESIA HAVING BEEN GIVEN BY THE PRINCIPAL INVESTIGATOR. TO BE CORRECTED BY: JULY 28, 2006.
