13 kittens removed and adopted out

### Respect for Fish Day

August 1 has been designated Respect for Fish Day by 'In Defense of Animals' to raise awareness about the plight of fish. Fish are the planet's most widely abused animals, but their suffering receives the least attention. Trillions of fish are mistreated and killed every year in the food industry, for sport, in the pet trade and in laboratories. Scientific evidence has demonstrated that fish are capable of feeling pain, but they are seldom protected with any animal welfare legislation. Eighty-six percent (86%) of released fish caught for sport, are often injured and suffer until they die.
