ATTENDING VETERINARIAN AND ADEQUATE VETERINARY CARE.

Section 2.33 (b) (5) states - "Each research facility shall establish and maintain programs of adequate veterinary care that include: (5) Adequate pre-procedural and post-procedural care in accordance with current established veterinary medical and nursing procedures."

1. Goat # 93 on Protocol #20-09 died unexpectedly post-operatively during recovery from general anesthesia on 2/8/11. Goat #11 underwent the same anesthesia regimen the following week on 2/15/11. Goat #11 was noted to have a prolonged recovery time from the anesthesia and the clinical veterinarian was contacted. The animal was monitored post-operatively by the clinical veterinarian until it was fully alert and recovered from general anesthesia.

Upon further investigation, it was determined that the investigator: (1) misread the dose for the injectable anesthetic and administered 4 times the recommended dose to both Goats which resulted in the prolonged recovery time from anesthesia; and (2) failed to monitor Goat #93 until it had fully recovered from general anesthesia which led to the animal's death.

All personnel at a research facility who are responsible for providing veterinary care to study animals should provide adequate pre-procedural and post-procedural care in accordance with current established veterinary medical and nursing procedures to ensure the health and well being of the animals.

Following this incident, the clinical veterinarian provided additional instruction and training to the investigator on the topics of administration of anesthesia and monitoring procedures for animals following general anesthesia. Several Goats have undergone anesthesia since the re-training and there have been no additional incidents.

The Registrant has taken appropriate measures to address this item and it has been corrected.
